Dear Parents/ Carers,

October has got off to a good start with our three parents curriculum evenings this week and lots of great learning going on in school.

The communication this week sets out some more important information for you to be aware of in order to support your child.

Entrance and Exit changes next week

Next week we are having the fencing at the back corner of the school fixed and updated. To enable this to happen we will be fencing off the corner of the car park for the week and changing access arrangements in the morning and afternoon.

Therefore, for next week, both taxis and parents, instead of entering on the lefthand side of the school and exiting on the right-hand side of the school:

- Taxis will be entering and exiting on the left-hand side (coming in as usual but going out the same way they came in) and
- Parents will be entering on the right-hand side of the school (rather than the usual left-hand side) and exiting on the right-hand side.

We apologise for the change, but we hope that this will avoid the fencing compound and help access for next week.

Wiltshire SEND inspection

An OfSTED/CQC Area SEND inspection has been announced for Wiltshire this week. This is a three-week inspection which focuses on the effectiveness of local area arrangements for children and young people with SEND.

Inspectors' activities in the first two weeks are carried out remotely and then they will be on-site for the third week.
